




Each of the 15 member team must raise \$1,500 to participate in the mission trip. Your financial support in any amount will be greatly





Tara, a young Adventist Hmong woman, recently received a call that brightened her day. Tara had translated GLOW tracts into the Hmong language. She recently led a group of Hmong church members to distribute the Hmong tracts at a large New Year's Hmong festival. Not long later, a woman called Tara and told her a story. This woman (whom we will call Martha), was a Sunday-keeping Hmong Christian. Martha had recently stumbled upon the topic of the Sabbath in her study. She was impressed to keep the Sabbath but was looking for some more evidence. She happened to be at the Hmong New Year's festival when all of a sudden she received--of all tracts--the Hmong tract on the topic of the Sabbath! She called the phone number on the back after reading the tract and was connected with Tara. Martha related her story and ended up coming to the local Hmong SDA church that very weekend.

Ginger Beets

2 cups grated raw beets

2 teaspoons grated ginger root

1 tablespoon maple syrup (optional)

1 tablespoon tamari

1 teaspoon lemon juice

Beets are high in Vitamin A and help cleanse the liver. If you are making several dishes at once with your salad shooter, grater or food processor, do the beets last. That way, you won't have pink vegetables and you won't need to stop to disassemble and wash any equipment.

In a small bowl, combine all ingredients and toss. Let the flavors blend for a few minutes before serving. Top with sprouts for a festive side dish. Serves 4.
